Notice: Mandatory Electronic Filing Effective May 1, 2010

The United States Bankruptcy Appellate Panel of the Tenth Circuit (“BAP”) announces that effective May 1, 2010, the BAP will adopt mandatory electronic filing. With limited exceptions, all documents submitted to the BAP must be filed electronically using the BAP Appellate CM/ECF system.

The public comment period regarding the proposed amendments to the BAP’s local rules expired on March 26, 2010, and the BAP anticipates that the amendments will become effective on May 1, 2010. The amendments include 10th Circuit BAP Local Rule 8008-1(a), which requires electronic filing in most situations.

If you previously registered as an e-filer with the BAP, you already have the login and password (separate from your PACER login and password), which serves as your BAP Appellate CM/ECF login and password. If you have not yet registered as an e-filer, please click on the link entitled “CM/ECF & PACER” on the BAP website (www.bap10.uscourts.gov) for step-by-step instructions and a training presentation that details the registration process. Registration is free, easy, and takes approximately five minutes or less.
