

SUMMARY OF WICHITA EIC CASE DISCOVERY SCHEDULE

effective October 25, 2011

<u>Date</u>	<u>Deadline</u>
December 5, 2011	All parties shall provide Rule 26(a)(1) initial disclosures
March 1, 2012	Debtors shall file their 2011 Federal and State Tax Returns
March 16, 2012	If not eligible for EIC or tax refund, Debtors shall amend Schedule C - Exemptions and file a Notice and Request to Remove Bankruptcy Case from EIC jointly administered cases
March 16, 2012	If Debtors not eligible for EIC or tax refund, Trustee shall withdraw objection to EIC exemption previously claimed
April 1, 2012	All parties shall designate their expert witnesses, if any.
May 1, 2012	All expert reports due
June 15, 2012	All discovery shall be completed
July 15, 2012	Agreed Final Pretrial Conference Order due
July 16, 2012	Stipulations of controlling fact due, if the constitutional challenge can be submitted on stipulations and briefs
August 1, 2012	Dispositive motions, if any, are due
August 6, 2012	Trustees' briefs on stipulated facts due
August 21, 2012	Debtors' and Attorney General's response briefs on stipulated facts due
September 4, 2012	Trustees' reply briefs on stipulated facts due
