
GENERAL ORDER

In the absence of appropriations or a continuing resolution, whether as a result of the failure to pass a continuing resolution or budget, or as the result of the absence of funding due to a so-called debt ceiling, the Clerk shall implement the following contingency plan that will enable the court to fulfill its statutory duty to continue to hear and resolve cases.

Because all judges and their personal staffs, as well as all other officers and employees of the court, perform functions that are necessary and essential to the continued resolution of cases according to normal schedules and priorities, I ORDER them to continue to work full time during any funding lapse as they may be directed by their supervisors. To the fullest extent practicable during a funding lapse, court activities shall be limited to those functions necessary and essential to the continued resolution of cases. The incurrence of travel and other expenses shall be limited to those necessary to support the operations of the court.

Unless so modified or revoked by the Chief Judge, this Order shall remain in effect throughout the duration of Fiscal Year 2014.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
