JUDGMENT ON DECISION

This case is before the Court on the Chapter 7 Trustee’s Motion and Notice to Employ Attorney Nunc Pro Tunc. The Trustee located substantial assets in the Clements’ no-asset Chapter 7 case, reopened the case which is set to pay a 100% dividend on the claims, but failed to file an Application for Employment as set forth in 11 U.S.C. § 327. In his motion, the Trustee seeks to have his law firm employed nunc pro tunc so that he may collect his fees and expenses incurred while pursuing the Clements’ assets. The United States Trustee objected to the Trustee’s motion. The Chapter 7 Trustee, Edward J. Nazar appears pro se. The United States Trustee appears through William F. Schantz. The Court carefully reviewed the relevant facts and law and has issued its Memorandum Opinion of even date resolving this dispute.

For the reasons stated in that Memorandum, IT IS SO ORDERED THAT the Trustee’s Motion and Notice to Employ Attorney Nunc Pro Tunc is GRANTED.
