trial, the arguments of counsel, and the record, the Court found that the plaintiff did not satisfy its burden in proving it was entitled to judgment on its Complaint. Accordingly, the defendant is entitled to discharge his debt to the plaintiff.

P. 52, rather than any paraphrased findings set out in this Order. The Court reserves the right to issue further findings and conclusions.
