JUDGMENT ON DECISION

This proceeding was before the Court for decision following submission of the matter on stipulations and briefs. Debtors Jon and Lisa Delgado sought to discharge the post-petition accruing interest and other collection charges on Jon's student loan. The debtors appear by counsel Donald B. Clark. ECMC appears by N. Larry Bork of Topeka. There were no other appearances. The Court reviewed the stipulations and relevant materials, and has issued its Memorandum Opinion of even date resolving this dispute.

For the reasons stated in that Memorandum, IT IS SO ORDERED THAT ECMC's objection to confirmation of the debtors' plan is SUSTAINED. Debtors are granted 10 days from the date of the entry of this Memorandum and accompanying Judgment on Decision in which to file an amended plan which omits the offending provision concerning post-petition interest, to convert this case to chapter 7, or to dismiss.
