MEETINGS OF CREDITORS)

Because of developing issues with the COVID-19 virus and the national and state declarations of emergency by the President of the United States and the Governor of Kansas, § 341 meetings of creditors scheduled in many bankruptcy cases (Chapters 7, 11, 12, 13, and subchapter V cases) pending in the District of Kansas, including reset and continued meetings, beginning March 18, 2020, were suspended or rescheduled until a future date to be determined or will be suspended or rescheduled. All deadlines triggered by the first date set for the meeting of creditors under § 341 (whether imposed by the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, or this Court’s Local Rules) in those cases are continued. A notice of the reset § 341 meeting date (and in Chapter 13 cases, the associated confirmation hearing date) will be issued in each case impacted by this order by the Court. The reset § 341 date will be deemed to be the initial date set for the § 341 meeting and all deadlines triggered by the initial date set for the § 341 meeting date will run from that new “initial” date.

The Clerk of Court is directed to serve the reset notice (when it is issued) on the debtor(s), debtor(s) counsel, and all parties in interest.
