IN THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF KANSAS STANDING ORDER NO. 18-3 ORDER AMENDING RULES TO ALLOW PAYMENT BY ACH

The Judges of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Kansas have determined that it will increase the convenience of the parties and will improve the efficiency of the Court to allow the Clerk of the Court to accept electronic payments by Automated Clearing House (ACH). This Standing Order makes minor technical amendments to the Local Bankruptcy Rules to accommodate ACH payments.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Appendix 1-01 to D. Kan. Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005.1, Paragraph I.D is amended as follows:

D. Filing Fees. For filings that require a fee to be paid, the attorney must use a credit card to promptly pay the fee through Pay.gov. The court will not maintain electronic billing or debit accounts for lawyers or law firms.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Standing Order and these amendments to Appendix 1-01 to D. Kan. Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005.1, Paragraph I.D are effective on the date of this order.
