ORDER OF ADOPTION

Pursuant to the authority vested in this court by rule and statute, and following notice and a public comment period;

IT IS ORDERED that the following attached amendments to the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Kansas are adopted, supersede existing rules bearing the same number where applicable, and become effective March 17, 2022. Specifically, the court adopts LBR 3002.2, adopts LBR 3003.1, deletes LBR 5005.1, Appendix 1-01, subparagraph VIII.C, and amends LBR 9011.4. The court also consolidates the forms within these rules into a single appendix and makes corresponding technical amendments to LBR 1007.1, LBR 1009.1, LBR 2004.1, and LBR 3015(b).2.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that superseded rules or subsections are repealed effective March 17, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Standing Order 20-2 is abrogated by the amendment to LBR 9011.4.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attached Standing Orders of the court are adopted and become effective March 17, 2022, and supersede the court's previous Standing Orders which are repealed effective March 17, 2022.
